
Dear friends,

With Wellington at COVID alert level 2 and Australia wrestling with outbreaks in most states and the suspension of the cross Tasman no quarantine travel bubble, it is essential that we remain vigilant. ## Holy Ground campsite: upgrade of camp house

HopeWhangarei has some close associations with the Holy Ground Camp Site, our new Council member Neil Croucher is the chairperson of the camp committee and shares with us the upgrade of the camp house and a possibility of people to help with the painting. He writes...

### Holy Ground Camp House Upgrade Project. Parua Bay.

After 3 weeks the camp house upgrade is going well. Thank you for all those who have been praying and a thank you to those who have donated time of financial gifts to the project. John Schruers, Joseph Aoina and his family, as well as Doug and Luke who are John's work team have been working very hard to get things to where we are at the moment.

As with any old building much more than expected was found lurking behind the walls and below the floors which has meant more work and more costs. The good news is that through having to uncover most of the internal walls we will be able to complete the majority of the wall and ceiling insulation work, some of which was not planned to be done until next year. We are all very excited by the changes in the living, bathroom and office spaces which will allow for more a more open plan feel and look. There is even a small deck which will now become one of the entrance ways to the house.

There is a plan to extend the deck round the corner of the lounge area but we do not have the funds to do this at the moment. Therefore if there is anybody who feels they could give a financial donation to this specific part of the project that would be great as we could get the work done this time round.

Otherwise I would just like to give a heads up that in about 2 or 3 weeks' time we will be looking for a team of volunteers to help with the painting phase of the project. Please can you think about whether you could offer some time to this. I will give more detailed notice of the painting working bees once we know the exact timeline.
