On June 19th he posted a short 7 minute talk on "*A Church and a Medical centre*" which reflects the vision for, and the faith that accompanied that to establish the Te Aroha Noa medical centre that is part of the Central business block. I love how in this story a number of things came together to establish what has been for nearly 30 years now a compassionate healing ministry for Whangarei. These were: the desire and availability of two doctors; the vision of St Andrews at the time; a verse that Grahame had seen on a hospital in Manhattan; a large financial gift and the availability a building. When we are genuinely seeking God's guidance for our lives He will so often encourage us with a number of doors opening up. The Alpha Course that our church has used over many years now speaks of 5 "C S-es" of God's guidance: Commanding Scripture; Controlling Spirit; Counsel of the Saints; Circumstantial signs and Common Sense. In seeking God's guidance, often two or three will help us to discern God's way ahead.

Our church is currently seeking God's way forward in two or three areas ... The inner city chaplaincy ... the use of the Business block ... and the future of children, young people and family ministry. Will you join the Council in praying for God's guidance for these? Also, there may be something you are seeking God's guidance on in your own life.

Be assured that God will guide those who seek Him. It then takes courage and faith to step into His plans:

"11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. 12 Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. 13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart" Jeremiah 29: 11-13
