Dear friends,

This Sunday we are having a combined 'gospel and healing' service at HopeCentral at 10am. John Fergusson is our guest preacher. Many of you are familiar with John from other times he has spoken and ministered here at Hope, both in services and weekend seminars on the Holy Spirit and healing ministry. John has also lead mission trips in Nepal, where Lorne Campbell and others from our church have been part of his team.

This is a great opportunity to invite friend's neighbours or family members along. Even those who do not normally come to church. Particularly those who might need a touch from the Lord (if you don't mind me using that Christian jargon). Can I also please encourage you to pray during the week that God might meet people at their point of need at this service, and bring healing, wholeness and salvation. The greatest healing of all is when people come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Of course we often have questions and concerns about healing. Does God heal today? What about those who do not get healed? In Rob Yule's (former moderator of the Presbyterian Church of Aotearoa New Zealand) book '*The Holy Spirit as Person and Power*' makes the point that it often is those who are involved most in praying for people to be healed that wrestle with those questions the most. In the end we find ourselves in the tension of the all-ready but not yet. The fact that in Christ the Kingdom of God has been inaugurated, sin and death are defeated at the cross and resurrection, but we await the consummation of that when Christ returns.

One of the resources that we have made available to people to help wrestle with this is the Prayer course (part 2) or the unanswered prayer course where Pete Greig works through the challenge of what happens when God does not seem to answer Prayer. Pete was at the forefront of a worldwide prayer movement (ThyKingdomCome is part of that) and his wife was diagnosed with a very rear and severe form of epilepsy. No matter how much prayer, or pleading with God seemed to help. But Pete and his wife worked through that and came to a place of knowing God's presence and peace. This series is available for use by our connect groups, or on line if you want to do it as an individual.

Having said that I still believe in the power of God to heal. I believe in praying for people to be healed, trusting in God's goodness and mercy. I find comfort in John Wimber's great quote when he was asked about healing by secular media ' All I know is that I have seen more people healed since I stopped believing that God did not heal people today and so I didn't pray and have started believing that God does heal people today and so pray."

PS:- Matuku Moana is the maori name which covers two different types of Heron that populate out shoreline. The very common white faced Heron and the rarer Pacific Reef Heron. Pacific Reef Heron's are squatter birds, they are a deeper grey with no white heads, and they have green thicker legs and a thicker grey beak. There are only about 300-500 of them in New Zealand. It is great to have a few of them around the Whangarei area. One that frequents Onerahi at half tide. Here is a sequence of four photos featuring that bird. As it moves from stealthy hunter mode to full on puffed out bird and back. Their eyes are very intense and yellow in colour.
