

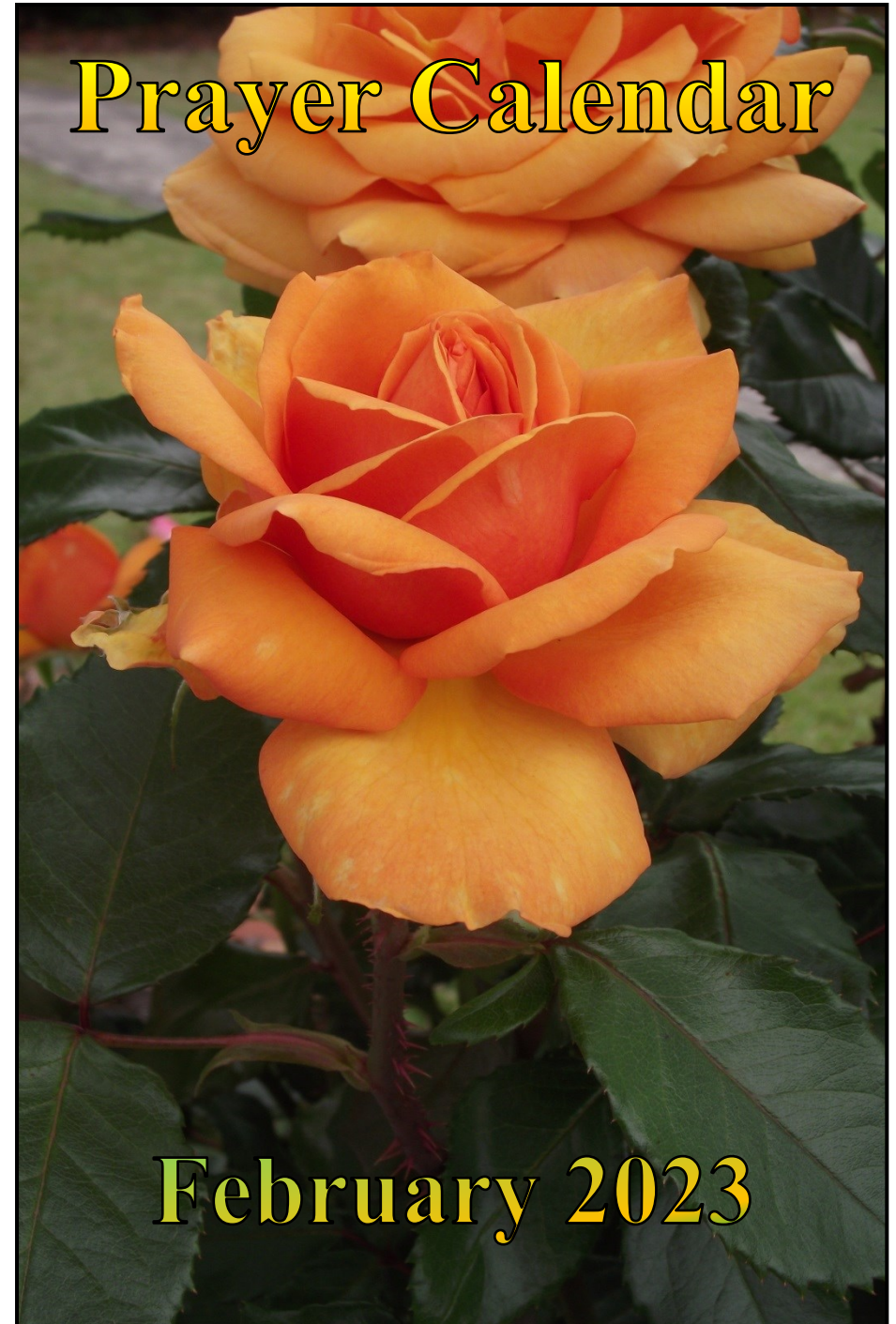


## DRAYERNET
