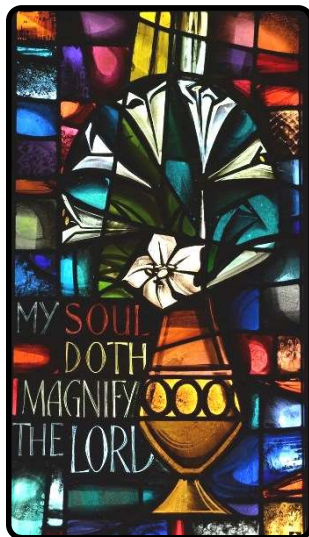


PrayerNet
