Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I am re-reading Tim Keller's book *CenterChurch* at the moment. Tim Keller, who died earlier this year, was the minister at Redeemer Presbyterian Church in New York. A church that saw quite amazing growth, at the heart of a very secular city. He was also involved with renewal and church planting in many cities and countries around the world. At the heart of *CenterCity* and Keller's ministry is the assertion that we all need to experience and continue to experience a renewed sense of Christ's great love for us. That all we do and how we act then comes out of that Gospel vision, individually and corporately as a church. The amazing truth of the gospel, that while we were yet sinners Christ came and died for us and was raised to life again and through that has reconciled us with God. A prayer at the centre of that conviction comes from Paul's letter to the Ephesians... a pray I share with you...

I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸ may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

-Ephesians 3:16-19

I must admit when I read this prayer that the lyrics of an old spiritual come to mind... for me that comes with the beat and horn section of the 1990's kiwi band Supergroove's song 'Can't Get Enough'

"so high can't get over it, so low can't get under it, so wide can't get round it. O rock my soul"

But also that this prayer is prayed for those who are already committed to Christ. A prayer that we may continually be amazed, filled, inspired, energised, motivated and moved to action by the great grace and love of Christ. Keller starts the section of his book where he quotes this passage by saying

"Gospel renewal does not simply seek to convert nominal church members; it also insists that all Christians-even committed ones- need the spirit to bring the gospel home to their hearts for deepened experiences of Christ's love and power."

May Paul's prayer be our experience and our prayer for our church... Renew us O God.
