Howard is away this week attending the Abide Church leadership Conference in Auckland and so, I, Lorne, will provide a brief introduction to our weekly newsletter, by way of updating you on my health situation.

Sue and I would like to thank the many people who have been praying for us during this time of chemo treatment. Some have asked how's it going and where are you up to? I was due to have my last round this week, but due to a very nasty skin rash, they postponed the treatment for 2 weeks. So, all going well, my last treatment will be on Oct 24 and Oct 25. Apart from the skin rash the other side effect is tiredness!

Following my last treatment, I will most likely have a PET scan towards the end of the year to determine the effectiveness of the chemo. A recent scan I had showed the Lymphoma in my pancreas had decreased in size a little, but not as much as they had hoped. We keep praying...

Amid all this we are in good spirits, and we are so very grateful for the medical profession who have been caring for us. It was a joy 10 days ago taking two boxes of Orchids, supplied by the Hansen family, up to the Jim Carney Cancer centre to give to the teams up there. It was late on a Friday afternoon, and everyone was winding up for the day ... but they all stopped ... eyes lit up ... and they were so grateful. We went away feeling blessed by the joy filled surprise shown by the team. I think that is why Luke records Pauls words to the Ephesian elders: "remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'" Acts 20: 35

I'd like to thank Howard and the team at the church office who have also been most supportive and understanding as I endeavour to fulfil my duties.
